## CPA Criteria Scoresheet Reference

Reach Impact: Local, regional, national. What is the impact, geographically? A local project could be very valuable locally, but not necessarily national. "Local" is Pittsfield, "regional" is Berkshire County and "national" is anything beyond.

Economic Impact: Will the project bring money to the city/area?

Underserved Communities Impact: Does this reach racial, ethnic, age or economic communities?

Local Employment Impact: Does this project hire locally? From the city? From the county? If not, why not?

Leverages other Funding/Partners: Does the project leverage other funding? Is CPA the only funder? Does project have other partners who contribute or support?

Community Support: The CPC will assess the kind of community support through letters of support or attendance at public meetings.

Urgency: What are the consequences of not funding this project? What kind of damage might take place?

Practicality/Feasibility: Is there a timeline to complete the project that is practical and within budget?

Aligns with City priorities: Does it align with the City planning documents? (Community Preservation Plan, City Master Plan)

Preserves/utilizes City assets: Does the project support a property that is owned by the city?
